## REMEMBER KASSINGA

Eleven years ago, on 4 May, South African troops massacred hundreds of Namibians in a refugee camp in the south of Angola. This incursion and the brutal military action was made possible by the fuelling of the apartheid regime by Shell.

Today, as we mourn the estimated 582 people including 120 children who were brutally murdered in Kassinga, we demand that Shell withdraw from South Africa and Namibia and end its collaboration with the racist regime.
